

SOUND INFORMATION FOR: Moi

Sound

The sponsor is responsible for sound and lighting. The technical rider is attached. If Moi is flying in, backline equipment will also be required. A full list of needs is included on page 2.

Runner

If possible, it would be greatly appreciated if someone from your organization who is familiar with the area and has a vehicle, could be on hand to assist MOI in case of any quick errand that might be necessary to make the performance possible. Most likely they will not be called upon, but it's better to be prepared.

Transportation

Air - Cost of air travel, and local transportation must be provided by the sponsor. If flying in for a concert, please make sure the vehicle picking up MOI is big enough to hold all luggage and equipment. MOI consists of 4-6 people including personal items, as well as gear.

Ground - Cost of mileage is \$0.60 a mile. The exact amount will be calculated on your contract, and is due on show date. MOI travels in a 29 ft. RV with attached trailer. Please provide a sufficient parking area, with 110 power available.

Lodging

A quality hotel is requested. Most hotel chains will be sufficient. Please request non-smoking rooms, clean, close to the venue, and convenient to shopping and restaurants. Two- three rooms will be needed (specifics will be on contract) and payment of the rooms should be made in advance and confirmation information provided ahead of time. Rooms should be reserved in the sponsor's name, and room keys provided upon arrival.

Meals

Travel - When MOI is traveling an excess of 100 miles to your event, per diem will be requested for meals eaten on the way to the venue.

Green Room - 1 case of bottled water should be provided and available before, during and after the show. Also, healthy snacks are always appreciated. If the event is in the morning, fruit, muffins, or bagels, and juice would be great.

Per Diem - a per diem for meals (twelve dollars cash per person per meal) is requested upon arrival. Amount will be specified in your contract. If meal is provided, healthy meals are appreciated, grilled chicken, sandwiches, or salads are always great!

The Technical sound rider for MOI

Please present this to your sound technician prior to the day of the concert.

Monitors

Band needs at least 3 floor wedges for monitors. There should be two separate mixes. 1st Mix - Moi's Guitar and vocal only. 2nd Instruments + Moi's Guitar and vocal.

Vocals

There should be 1 vocal mic with boom stand for Moises.

Moi's Guitar

An SM57 mic is preferable to mic the amp, but if you have a particular mic you like to use, MOI is flexible.

Bass guitar-Matt

He has a DI connection on his pedal board. He'll just need an XLR to connect to the board.

Drums-Nate

Nate usually plays a 3 piece kit; 3 drums (snare/kick/floor tom), and 2 cymbals (hi-hat/ride), so only 4-6 channels are necessary to amplify it. Obviously in all situations, drums do not have to be mic'd, so we leave this to your discretion, as you know your venue much better than us.

For bass drum, we suggest; Akg D112, Shure Beta 52, Shure Beta 91 or an audix D4.

For snare, we suggest; Shure SM57, Audix D1

For floor toms, we suggest; Shure Sm57's, Audix D2/D4's, or Shure Beta 91's

For overheads/hihats, any condenser mic you think is acceptable for that use is ok with us.

Traveling

In the event that MOI flies out to play for you, Backline gear will be needed. Here's a list of easy-to-find, suggested equipment.

Electric Guitar Amps (*any one of the following*) - Fender Twin Reverb, Fender Deluxe, or Fender Deville. Mesa Nomad. Vox AC15.

Bass Guitar Cabinets (*any one of the following*) 2x10 or 4x10 w/tweeter configurations - Hartke, SWR, Ampeg, David Eden, or Ashdown cabinets.

Drums (*Nate will usually fly with a snare drum and his cymbals*)

Suggested drums. Any 5 piece kit from **Dw**, **Gretsch**, **Yamaha** or **Premier** should do fine. Suggested sizes (20" or 22" bass, 10" 12" 14" toms)

Needed hardware; snare stand, 3 cymbal stands, all mounting hardware for toms, Hihat stand, and a drum throne.
